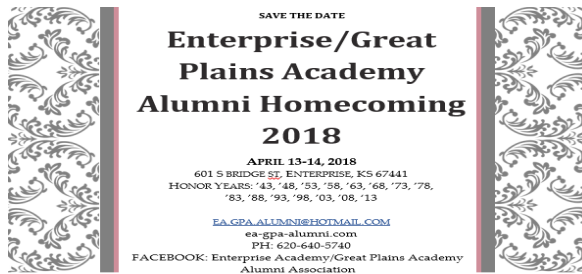

### GUEST SPEAKER

Guest Speaker for the weekend will be former principal Don L. Weatherall Ph.D. Weatherall graduated from Union College in 1956. He married Ardyce Kuhnke and they have three daughters (the youngest born in Abilene, KS) and four grandchildren. The Weatheralls began their work at Platte Valley Academy where they served for eight years. They then moved to Enterprise Academy where he was principal from 1964 to 1969. Other positions Don held in their 50 years of service in the Adventist educational system included principalships of Highland Academy in Portland, TN and Kahili Adventist School in Kauai, HI.

He also served as Education Superintendent of the Florida Conference, Associate Director of Education of the Southern Union Conference in Atlanta, GA and Assistant Director of Education of the North American Division in Silver Spring, MD.

After retiring five times they settled in Atlanta, Ga for a number of years and for the last five years have lived at the Florida Living Retirement Center, operated by the Florida Conference. He is very active in the Center as well as the Florida Living SDA Church.

Weatherall came back for the 1993 Enterprise Alumni Weekend as a speaker and we look forward to him returning to Enterprise to be our guest speaker this year.
